Stop action - standard FPS - 0:10

Quicktime 7 (PRO) - only on FCP stations

In Quicktime 7 (Pro) you open an image sequence from the file menu. Put all your photos in a folder and make sure they are numbered sequentially. Then select open image sequence and navigate to the folder containing your images.
